North Norfolk District Council Disabled Parking

Disabled bays are provided in all North Norfolk District Council hardstanding car parks, and can be used by those registered and displaying the national Blue Badge. Disabled parking is NOT free of charge and disabled users must pay the usual car parking fee. However, disabled drivers displaying a Blue Badge will be permitted 30 minutes additional parking over the expiry time of the ticket purchased. Cromer Promenade (accessed via Melbourne Slope) is disabled parking only.

Out and About: Museums and Steam Trains

Cromer Museum

All public galleries and spaces are fully accessible. A lift connects the ground and first floor of the museum. Carers are not charged admission. Assistance dogs are welcome. The Mo—Sheringham Museum

The museum is fully accessible, with lift access to all three floors and room for wheelchairs in all exhibition areas. To avoid those seawall steps you can take the ramp to the left when you reach the seawall, not right, then double back to the museum entrance. Henry Blogg Museum

There is no parking available at the museum but there disabled parking on the Promenade allowing level access to the museum or passengers can be dropped off at the museum. The building is fully accessible for wheelchair users with an internal lift and mezzanine. For more details please phone 01263 511294

Thursford Collection between Fakenham and Holt NR21 OAS Free Parking. Large, gravel Car Park has designated spaces for disabled parking. A hard surface path leads from the car park to the complex. Wheelchair accessible toilets are located on the ground floor in the main complex and in the courtyard, but not in the car park. Essential carers get free access. North Norfolk Railway at Sheringham, Weybourne and Holt

Although the majority of the services include one of the two specially refurbished coaches which accommodate wheelchair users, we would recommend a phone call before the day of travel so they can try to arrange for the necessary accommodation to be available for you. Although there are usually toilets on each train, the width of the corridor does not permit the passage of a wheelchair. For passengers with limited mobility we can accommodate wheelchairs in our brake van whilst the passenger travels with their friends in our standard coaches. Guide dogs are welcome, free of charge. Bure Valley Railway Wroxham & Aylsham

The Bure Valley Railway offers a fully accessible experience for a great day out. Both Aylsham and Wroxham stations are all on one level. There are six specially designed coaches which can carry wheelchairs easily. Each has a special seating arrangement plus double doors on both sides and detachable ramps. Each accommodates four manual wheelchairs securely. Other types of wheelchair may be carried depending on their size. When the BVR is running a full three-train service, every train normally has two of these coaches, giving disabled passengers a completely free choice of which train to catch. Small electric scooters or wheelchairs can be accommodated within accessible carriages provided they are not too large, or heavy. For more details phone 01263 733858

Cromer Pier Pavilion Theatre NR27 9HE www.cromerpier.co.uk Disabled Parking is available on Cromer Promenade and there is also a drop-off point here, for those parking in the town and taxi-ing down to the pier. There are ramps to the Pier entrance and wheelchair access to the Pavilion Bar and Theatre. Limited wheelchair positions are available in the auditorium, and very limited wheelchair storage is available. Please check with the Box Office team at the time of booking. Mobility scooters must be parked outside and not in the Pavilion Bar or Auditorium. Guide dogs are welcome and a Disabled toilet is located in the Pavilion Bar foyer. There is also a Disabled toilet in Tides Restaurant. The venue has a Hearing Loop System: handsets or neck loops are available. Pre-booking of these is advisable. Blickling Hall, Gardens & Park (National Trust)

Pay & Display Car Park, Free to National Trust Members

The house, garden, cafes, shops and wider estate are open all year round. You'll find ramps, smooth terrain and a multi-use trail for easy access whatever the weather. Blickling is equipped with ramps and lift access, so visitors can enjoy seeing the hall's rooms and intriguing collections. With impressive paths throughout the garden and walled garden, you can enjoy seeing centuries of expert planting all year round. The multi use trail through the parkland is an accessible route for all abilities, open all year round. The terrain is suitable for both buggies and adapted wheelchair users, so whatever the weather, this four-mile trail will show you all the highlights of the wider estate. Wheelchairs and mobility scooters are available to hire for use in the garden. An adapted map for a useful guide to exploring the best bits, whilst avoiding steps and other obstacles is available. Sheringham Park (National Trust)

Pay & Display Car Park, Free to National Trust Members
Disabled parking in the main car park is 60 yards from the Visitor
Centre. A map of accessible routes is also available from the Visitor
Centre. Adapted toilets are located near the Visitor Centre and
there are 3 wheelchairs and a mobility scooter available to borrow.
Grounds are partly accessible, grass and hard gravel paths,
undulating terrain.

Holt Country Park

Disabled pay and display parking close to Disabled Toilet. Covered seating/picnic area, play area with seats. Easy going waymarked woodland walk suitable for wheel-chairs and pushchairs in dry weather as path is not paved/ hard-surfaced. Tel: 01263 516001

Pay & Display Car Park, Free to National Trust Members

There is designated disabled parking at the front of the main car park. Manual wheelchairs are available to borrow from the Visitor Reception, and a manual wheelchair and three personal mobility scooters are available to borrow from the Walled Garden Reception point. (Please note that bookings or reservations are not taken for these). Braille and large print guides available upon request from the entrance into the Hall. Reception, Squires Pantry and Shop are fully accessible to wheelchair users and an accessible toilet is available close to Visitor Reception. A map of accessible estate and garden routes is available on request from Visitor Reception. There is level access to the hall and gardens and all-weather paths through the woods. The Victory V path to the viewpoint is about 1 mile there and straight back, or 2 miles to continue through the woods and back along the drive to the hall, using the all-weather paths. Pensthorpe Natural Park

Free Parking; Open Daily

The reserve has designated paths for wheelchairs and pushchairs which can be pointed out to you by Pensthorpe staff on the day. Unfortunately, electric scooters are not available on site to hire, but a standard, push-along wheelchair is available for free. This can be reserved in advance for your visit and picked up from the viewing gallery. Please feel free to use your own electric scooter on the wheelchair friendly paths. There are seven disabled toilets on site: Found in the main toilet block, the Courtyard café, WildRootz and Hootz House. Holkham Beach

NR23 1AB (Pay & Display Car Park)

Turn left at the bottom of Lady Anne's Drive, on the A149 (opposite The Victoria Hotel), following the sign-post 'Easy access trail to hide ½ mile, 4 rest stops'. There is a hard-surfaced track with the pinewoods on the right, passing a small lagoon on your left. The George Washington Hide is half a mile on the left. From here there is also boardwalk access to the beach viewing platform. Fairhaven Woodland and Water Gardens

The garden, tea room, gift shop, plant sales and one boat are fully accessible. Three mobility scooters and two wheelchairs are available to borrow for your visit (please book in advance). A small donation to help maintain them is requested. As this is a woodland garden, some areas may be a little bumpy. With the help of grant funding a sensory garden has been created with mobility and visually impaired visitors in mind. Most of the information boards throughout the garden have Braille panels. Hearing loops are installed in the tea room, gift shop and on the boat Primrose. It is advisable to contact the gardens on the morning of your visit to confirm facilities are available, as sometimes weather conditions can restrict availability. Parking £5; Open daily; Free Entry

Parking charges apply for non-members. Free parking is available for carer or essential companion with disabled visitor. Two pushed wheelchairs available for hire free of charge. Assistance Dogs are permitted. The nature trails are mostly flat, boardwalks and rolled sand and gravel surfaces. There are four hides accessible via ramps/slopes. Broads Tours - River Trips

Wheelchair users are very welcome on all River Trips. Transfer onto the boats is via a hydraulic lift; these lifts are subject to a maximum weight and the turning ability of the wheelchair. Therefore some electric wheelchairs and mobility scooters are not able to access boarding via the lifts. One manual wheelchair is available to use for the duration of the trip if the wheelchair user is able to easily transfer from their own chair (please note free loan of our wheelchair is subject to availability).
