1. Turn to face west. The village green on your left, cottages on your of the parish church. right. Proceed along this narrow country lane, heading in the direction

2. Turn left into the by-road that leads down past the church. At the end of this byroad follow the lane round to the right.

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- Turn left at the finger sign which leads to a clearly defined path, and through the grazing meadow, heading towards the earth bank of the continue straight ahead. Pass through a gateway, and continue
- 4. Climb the side of the bank, the footpath runs along the top of it. Once on top of the bank turn left and head towards Runham Drainage Mill

5. Just after the third stile, (GR: 469101) leading to Runham Drainage

- Mill, descend from the bank side path.
- At the bottom of the bank, look out for the finger sign.
- 7. Turn immediately left onto a wide and clearly defined track and on your right comes to an end and the path begins to sweeps around which runs alongside the gardens of Manor Farm house and cottages to the right, look out for the finger sign pointing to a narrow pathway continue ahead, the river Bure should be behind you now.
